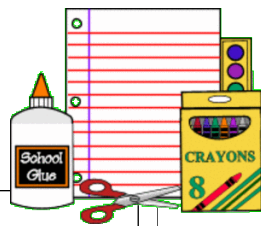

9th Grade Bible

- 3 ring binder—1 1/2 inch size max.— with dividers for notes, assignments, tests/quizzes, prayer journal, Bible journals.
- Loose leaf paper—enough to last all school year
- Bible for use at home, the school will provide a Chronological Bible to each student this year.
- Highlighters for Bible if desired.

- _____ (3) Packages 3 x 5 Note Cards
