STAFF WILL BE WEARING BIBLE TIME COSTUMES. Everyone is responsible for his or her own costume unless notified by the Nativity planning team. **ALL COSTUMES ARE DUE BY NOVEMBER 22nd**. - Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Shortness of breath
- Continuous cough
- Possible Exposure to Covid-19

OR TWO of the following:

- Chills
- Muscle pain/Body aches
- Congestion/Runny Nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New or loss of taste and smell
