Get your act together (literally) with costumes, props, and music, and turn in this form to Mrs. Tangi Olds by **Tuesday, February 28.** Your audition will be scheduled in March. **Come to auditions with a quality, family-friendly act that includes music, props, and lots of smiles!** We are committed to keeping our show length to a max of 2 hours.

This means that **NOT ALL ACTS WILL BE CHOSEN**, some may be chosen for only one night, and you should plan your **act to be LIMITED to LESS** than 3 minutes.

- You are responsible to ****submit your music, video, and/or media show by Monday, April 3 to Mrs. Olds**** in correct format & length for show. If you need an accompaniment track, it is your responsibility to find and purchase it. If you need help cutting music, please let Mrs. Olds know ASAP!

- Auditions should be conducted with **props and apparel/costume you will wear for the show**. We expect that you have practiced and that ****you will perform your entire act in costume during auditions****.

- **Following your audition, please plan for us to offer you constructive feedback, including any ideas to enhance your act for our specific audience/venue. **Expect that you may be called back to audition a 2nd time if you are asked to incorporate any changes, additions, or improvements.****

NOTE: After-school or in-school stage time to practice your act must be scheduled through Mrs. Tangi Olds. She schedules the stage for all Follies acts.
