



### Kindergarten

**Be sure to label all items with your child's name**

- Backpack - NO wheels please. It needs to be able to carry a three ring binder, a lunch box, and a few other things
- Pencil Box

- Crayons - Crayola 24-count, regular size
- Paints - Crayola Water Colors, 16-color set
- Construction Paper - large 12"x18", any color or multi-color
- Glue sticks - 1 large or 3 small
- Tissue - 1 box
- Paper towel - 1 roll
- Paper plates - boys] 1 package, snack size
- Paper cups - [girls] a package of 9 oz
- Animal crackers - 2 bags/container
- Pretzels - 1 bag/container
- Gym shoes to leave at school

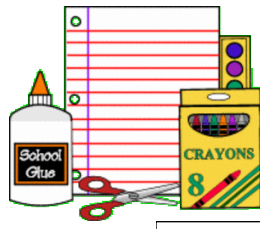

- Dividers [at least 4 dividers]
- Loose leaf paper or a notebook with clean tear perforation
- 1 pocket folder
- 1-2 boxes of tissues
- Flashdrive—this doesn't have to be dedicated only for English class but students should have one as needed

### High School Social Studies Classes

- 3x5 notecards
- Pens/pencils/highlighters
- 3-ring binder (3" at least)
- Dividers
- Loose leaf paper (no notebooks allowed)
- Flashdrive

### High School Math Classes

- 3 ring binder
- Dividers for 3 ring binder [5 or more tabs]
- Pencils/pen
- Notebook paper
- Calculator– TI-84
- 1 box Kleenex
- Hand sanitizer

### 9th Grade Bible

- 3 ring binder—1 inch
- 5 dividers with pockets or 5 three-hole folders for each divider section
- Loose leaf paper or spiral notebook
- Planner
- Writing utensils, highlighters, grading pen/marker [bright color], colored pencils]

- A Bible to use in class
- 3-ring binder
- Dividers

### 11th Grade Bible

- Bible
- 3x5 notecards

### PE Classes

- Each student needs to have 1 pair of designated gym shoes to keep at school in their locker.

# Supply List for Middle School

## MUST HAVE:

- \_\_\_\_\_ (1) Bible (OT & NT Bible, **Study Bible Preferred**, NIV preferred)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (1) USB Drive (aka: flash drive, thumb drive, etc)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (1) Three Ring Binder (Trapper Keeper style or at least 1 ½ inch wide)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (1) Zipper pencil pocket for Binder [if not already included in Trapper Keeper]
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2) Packages 8 Tab Dividers for Binder (NO Dividers with Pockets)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (4+) Packages Notebook Paper (College or Wide Ruled Acceptable—depending on your handwriting size; one package will be given to each teacher, also have some at home for homework, please know that most assignments will not be accepted on spiral bound paper)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (5) Composition Notebooks (Hard-backed, sewn pages; NOT spiral notebooks)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2) Spiral Bound Notebooks (For Science only)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (2) Packages 3 x 5 Note Cards
- \_\_\_\_\_ (1) Separate 1 inch Clearview Binder for Portfolio
- \_\_\_\_\_ Many Pencils (Regular or Mechanical, Mechanical Preferred)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Several Pens (Blue or Black Ink, NOT Red)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (1) Package Colored Pencils
- \_\_\_\_\_ (3) Glue Sticks
